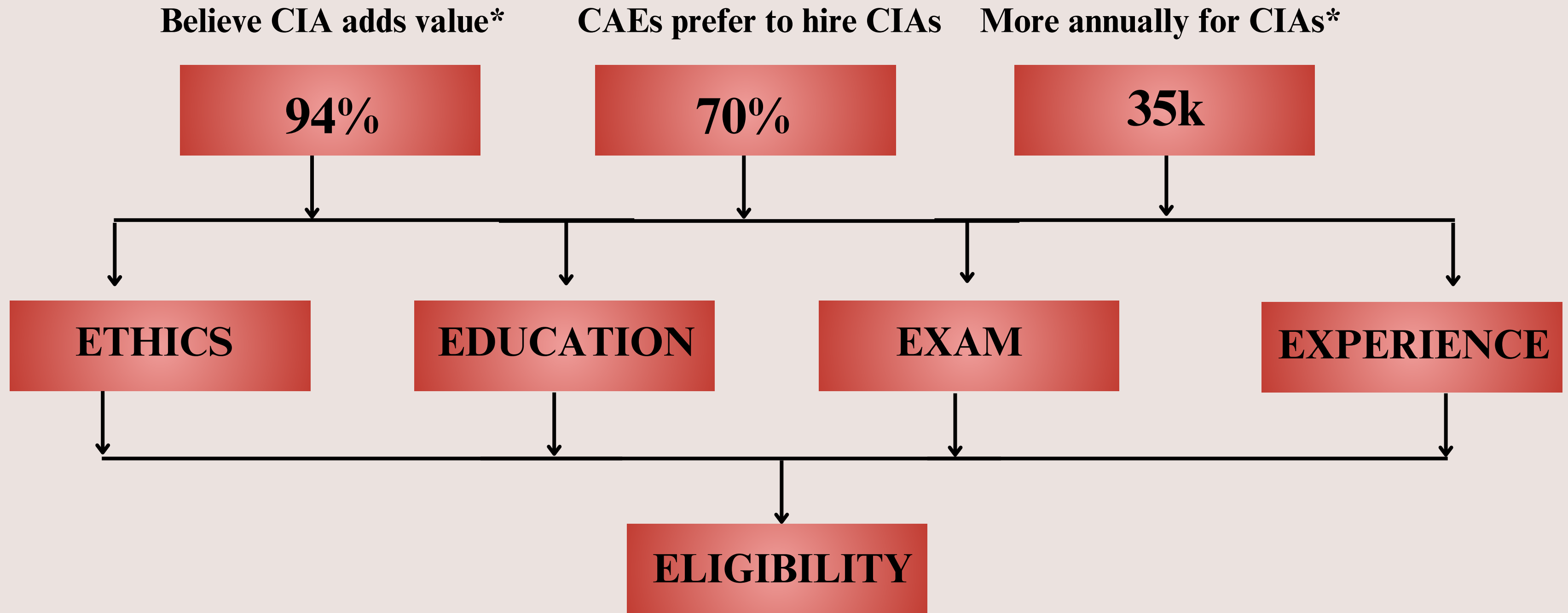

Supporting Requirement Exemptions;

- The Professional Certification Board (PCB) has approved work experience and education exemptions for Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) qualified members and an education exemption for U.S. Certified Public Accountant (CPA) active license holders pursuing the CIA certification. The supporting requirement exemptions were granted by the PCB because the experience and education requirements for ACCA members and education requirements for U.S. CPAs meet and/or exceed these requirements for the CIA program.

What Are The CIA CPE Requirements?

- Upon certification, CIAs are required to maintain their knowledge and skills and stay abreast of improvements and current developments.

As a CIA-holder, you must report and self-certify that you've completed the required continuing education hours. CIA CPE requirements differ greatly depending on whether you're a practicing, non-practicing, or retired CIA. There is also an inactive-grace period and an "inactive" status for those who do not complete the required hours.

- *In general, 40 hours of CPE hours are required to remain active but other professional development activities and/or certifications may be applied.*

CIA Exams Pass Rates:

Because the exam is totally computer based, you'll receive your unofficial score immediately upon completing the exam. Your exam score will not be shown as a percentage. Instead, it is converted to a scale score with 600 being set equal to the passing mark (roughly 75%). Your results will clearly read "PASS" if you scored above 600. If you failed, you'll see a numeric score on a scale between 250 and 600 so you can understand how close you came to passing.
